The admission of above Afghan Nationals will be subject to following terms/conditions and SOPs:-

- (i) they have proper entry visa in Pakistan for study purpose and after notifying/ confirmation of their provisional admission, the prescribed 'Foreign Students Information Sheet' proforma, will be forwarded to the HEC for further clearance and issuance of study visa. On completion of admission formalities, proper accommodation in the hostel will be allotted to them by the Principal Officer (Hostels/Chief Hall Warden) after following the prescribed procedure.
- (ii) all of them will qualify prescribed deficiency course(s) to be decided by the Board of Studies of the respective Department/Institute to bring their last degree at par with entrant qualification of this University. In order to avoid lecture shortage, extra lecture/assignments, if required, may be given to them by the concerned teachers.
- (iii) being nominees of HEC under the subject Project, possessing foreign passport, having no dual nationality, they will be exempted from appearing/ qualifying relevant GRE(Subject)/GAT etc. test, on the analogy of undergraduate programs. This will however, be subject to approval of the Vice Chancellor.
- (iv) as per written commitment, the University dues including hostel charges will be paid by the HEC at the rate not below prescribed by the University for foreign

students, on completion of each year of study period. The stipend/ allowances will be paid to the nominees, as and when funds will be received from HEC. While

forwarding cheque the name of student, detail of payment for dues and stipend/allowances will be indicated separately by the HEC.

- (v) since qualifying deficiency course(s) is part of academics and mandatory requirements for the award of degree, therefore, the HEC will also pay dues of semester(s) during which they will study deficiency course(s). Thus the dues/stipend will be paid by HEC beyond minimum duration of a degree. However, the dues for Summer Session for improvement of 'fail' or 'D' grade course(s) if any, will be paid by the concerned students as intimated by the HEC.
- (vi) on receipt of cheque from HEC, the Treasurer office will:-
- (a) adjust the dues including hostel charges by keeping proper record of receipt and adjustment/disbursement, for onward perusal/information of HEC as and when required, to reconcile the account.
- (b) the amount of stipend/allowances at the given rates of HEC will be placed on the disposal of the Directorate of Financial Assistance & University Advancement for disbursement to the concerned nominees against proper receipt. The said Directorate will also keep the record of receipt and disbursement for onward perusal/information of HEC as and when required, to reconcile the account. The academic progress of each student will also be maintained by the Directorate concerned in consultation with concerned offices of the University, for onward transmission to HEC as and when required.

However, this office will keep liaison between relevant University offices and HEC, if required with the assistance of Foreign Students' Advisor office.

In order to their safe movement, they should leave the Campus for City or elsewhere, with prior permission of the Principal Officer (Hostels/Chief Hall Warden) through the Foreign Students' Advisor.

The admission is subject to clearance from the Director Students Affairs (only UAF graduates) and verifications of original documents and eligibility criteria. ***In case of any discrepancy found at any time due to misreporting by the applicant, the admission shall be cancelled.*** They are directed to complete enrolment formalities upto **19/11/2018**, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled. The above said candidates are required to deposit dues at Main Campus.
