

Online Applying Procedure for Postgraduate

GAT/GRE (Subject) type test

For admission to (MS/MPhil/MSc(Hons) and PhD 2024-25

Visit UAF website <http://uaf.edu.pk/> and read Eligibility Criteria/ other instructions carefully before applying at following link: <http://postgraduate.uaf.edu.pk/>

1. First, click on **Register with UAF** and fill the Required Fields.
Have a valid **E-Mail ID**.
Valid **Passport in case of International Candidate**
Valid **CNIC/B-Form** number of the candidate.
Select the Password and remember for subsequent use.
2. After Registration, with UAF you will not receive **Confirmation Mail** from UAF on your Registered Email ID.
3. Login by using already given Email ID and Password and click on the LOGIN button.
4. After Login, Complete your Profile with Correct Information and print out fee voucher.
5. After Paying Fee Voucher in given bank, **Login again and Click on Apply** Button.
(don't use Enter button)
6. Upload the following Documents (**Candidate Picture, Terminal Degree and CNIC/B-Form**).
7. Size of the Documents or Pictures must be less than 700kb and JPEG format.
8. After Uploading, choose your terminal degree for test and Subject (Discipline name) and Print your Roll No. Slip.
9. On Test Day bring your Roll No. Slip, Original CNIC/B-Form and transparent a clipboard.

Note:

- ✓ Choose correct Terminal Degree on admission application forms.
- ✓ In case wrong information is added, the correction can be made by connecting on 041-9200189/9201081 or sending Email at postgraduate@uaf.edu.pk for **entry test**.
- ✓ For Correction write your query clearly and attach the relevant document. Without document the correction will not be entertained.

Important

- i. The entry test (GAT/GRE) will be centralized and conducted by the Controller of Examination and following proportion were proposed for GAT/GRE as recommended by the GSRB in its meeting held on 30-11-2020
- ii. The paper will consist of 100 MCQs with composition i.e. Subject=65%, Verbal Reasoning=10%, Quantitative reasoning=10%, Analytical Reasoning= 15%.
- iii. The duration of test will be 90 minutes
- iv. The aggregate weightage of entry test (GAT/GRE) and CGPA/marks obtained by the candidate will be 65% and 35%, respectively for admission (only for MS/MBA/MPhil/MSc (Hons), as recommended by the GSRB in its meeting held on 30-11-2020
- v. The fee for the entry (GAT/GRE) for MS/MBA/MPhil/MSc (Hons) will be Rs.1500/- and PhD Rs.2500/- respectively and the candidate will apply through online admission portal.
