**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATION/APPEARING IN
ENTRY TESTS AND ADMISSION TO FIRST DEGREE COURSES
DURING THE ACADEMIC SESSION, 2019-2020**

Before opening of on-line entry test registration form portal or thereafter to submit on-line application form for admission, each candidate should read these terms and conditions carefully.

A- ENTRY TEST:

1. Only two entry tests will be conducted according to the notified schedule at all the designated Centers of the University. The candidates appearing in Intermediate (Part-II) or equivalent examination and waiting their result, are eligible to apply for registration/appear in the entry test.
2. The test will contain MCQs from the Syllabus of Intermediate(Part-I&II) or equivalent qualification of the respective test streams approved by the University. Before selection of entry test streams, your own group of studies at Intermediate or equivalent level be carefully kept in view as after selecting test stream once, no candidate can be allowed to change the same. The detail of degree programs being offered during the next session, 2019-2020, minimum eligibility of each and matching entry test steam is given separately.
3. Before opening on-line registration portal, you should keep your as well as father's original/copy of Computerized National Identity Card or number given on 'B' form, Intermediate (Part-I) result card and other necessary documents, with you.
 - 3.1 While Registering yourself please make sure that you have used your own CNIC/B-Form number on Registration form as it cannot be changed after Registration. The system will allot you a **username and password, which should be saved by you on any paper/elsewhere, as it will be required for login and reference during all the remaining process.**
4. Read the instructions of entry test carefully and then fill up your personal information on fee voucher. Beware that correct information according to available documentary evidences be filled up, as it cannot be changed after its on-line submission. You will personally be responsible for submission of any wrong information/data. Then print out your fee voucher, deposit prescribed fee at the designated Bank(s) branch of **ABL** or **MCB** prior or on the last date.
5. After depositing dues open portal using your allotted Username and Password, fill up the entry test registration form and submit the same. Before its submission, selected Test Stream and Center be again checked carefully as it cannot be changed afterwards. Take print out your Roll No. slip wherein your roll number, time, date,

selected test stream and center will be indicated. Please reach at the centre atleast half an hour prior to given time and **do not bring cell phone or any other material** while entering into examination room.

6. The result of entry test(s) will be available on University website according to the announced schedule. If you want to re-appear in the 2nd entry test for improvement of marks, there is no need to register yourself again except to deposit dues by using your username and password. It may be noted that higher marks obtained in any of the test will be considered for admission purpose. The passing marks in entry test to apply for admission to DVM and Engineering programs of the Faculty of Agri. Engineering & Technology are 50%, whereas in other degree programs, the candidate having 50% or below marks can apply. However, their admission will be strictly on merit basis.

B- ON-LINE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM:

1. The detail of degree programs being offered during the academic session, 2019-2020, minimum eligibility criteria of each is given in a statement added separately. However, the University reserves the rights to revise any of the eligibility criteria, or condition at any stage without assigning any reason.
 - 1.1. After qualifying entry test(s), you are also required to submit on-line application form according to the schedule notified in the National Press and on University website. If you fail to submit the said form, you will not be considered for admission in any case. While submitting said application form select the degree program, category of admission carefully according to your entry test stream. You can select more than one degree program, category and Campus according to your qualification and choice.
 - 1.2. To apply for admission after qualifying Entry Test(s), just use your username and password.
 - 1.3. Fill up fee voucher and submit in the Bank.
 - 1.4. If you want to apply on Sports, Co-curricular activities and Evening College categories, separate fee voucher for each category will be required for submission of prescribed fee in the Bank separately.
 - 1.5. The fee voucher of candidate applying for these categories will only be considered, if he has downloaded voucher of open merit being compulsory requirement. Similarly, if separate fee for three categories indicated in 1.4 above, has not been deposited, you are in-eligible to apply against any of the said categories.
3. Your merit will be prepared on the basis of data/information provided by you through on-line system. Therefore, you will personally be responsible for provision of any wrong/incorrect and bogus information/data. It is clarified that passing marks in entry test to apply for admission to DVM and Engineering programs of the Faculty of Agri. Engineering & Technology are 50%, whereas in other degree programs, the candidate having 50% or below marks can apply. However, admission to all degree programs will be strictly on merit basis which **will be determined on the basis of marks**

obtained in Matric, Intermediate(Part-I) or equivalent examination and Entry Test with the ratio of 30:30:40 respectively, according to following given example.:-

- 3.1 Your district/residential category (rural/urban) aspect (where required), will be based on Matric school address mentioned on your Matric certificate.
- 3.2 The list of provisionally admitted candidates will be available on University website. SMS message will also be sent to each selected candidate on the given cell number. Afterwards, the candidate needs to submit semester dues on or before due date otherwise, admission will be treated as cancelled without any prior notice/intimation and candidate next on merit, will be considered for admission.
4. Your admission will be purely on provisional basis, which will be subject to declaration of combined Intermediate result. In case you secure marks within the minimum eligibility criteria of selected degree (excluding 20 marks of Hafiz-e-Quran), you will continue studies. In case, marks are less than the minimum eligibility criteria or you fail to pass all the subjects of Intermediate, the admission shall be considered as cancelled without any prior intimation/notice. In this eventuality, the dues deposited will be refunded on submission of proper application to the Treasurer's office as per percentage and time limit given below:-

* in case where dues were deposited after commencement of classes, the next day from depositing dues will be considered as date of convene of classes.

5. In case any:-
- (i) candidate quits admission at his/her own under any circumstances, the deposited dues shall not be refunded.
- (ii) information/data/document provided/indicated in on-line form or submitted thereafter in the University is found as **BOGUS/TAMPERED/FABRICATED** etc. at any stage of studies, the admission shall be cancelled retrospectively without assigning any reason and the deposited fee shall not be refunded.

DETAIL OF DEGREE PROGRAMS, MINIMUM QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION AND MATCHING ENTRY TEST STREAMS FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION, 2019-2020.

- The candidate applying for admission to following degree programs must have minimum qualification as given against each or equivalent recognized examination thereto from a recognized Institution securing minimum marks indicated with each excluding 20 marks of being Hafiz-e-Quran. These extra marks will be given to the candidates while calculating merit at the time of admission after conducting interview and test thereof according to schedule, which will be notified separately.
- Diploma holder candidates can apply only against their reserved seats on inter sea merit
