About the Organizer

National Agro-Tech Extension & Service Center (NATESC) is a governmental organization affiliated to the Ministry of Agriculture. It is composed of 22 divisions with more than 140 staffs. Training subjects contained agricultural technology extension system management, seed production and management, balanced fertilization, pest control, water-saving agriculture, crop cultivation technology, hybrid rice, tropical crop, agricultural biotechnology application etc.

Training Course Content Sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of the People's Republic of China, and organized by National Agro-Tech. The training course will make all the participants to understand the current conditions and achievements on cotton cultivation, breeding, pest and disease control, market development etc in China. And it will focus on introducing the China Mode to promote the cotton industry development. In the meanwhile, it will help to establish the communication and exchange platform between China and African countries, promote Chinese agricultural products to export to African market.
