NUTRITIONAL THERAPIES AGAINST LIFESTYLE RELATED DISORDERS

Pivotal linkages have been established between diet and health, diverting the consumers trend towards phytonutrients and bioactive moieties for specific physiological benefits. The major determinants of mortality and morbidity like obesity, diabetes, hypertension, dyslipidemia and even cancer are prevailing in the society owing to the unhealthy & sedative lifestyles, tobacco consumption and craving for refined foods. To avert the situation, nutritionists and health care professionals are striving hard for the revival of interest in the use of natural and healthy foods. Resultantly, the concept of designer foods rich in functional ingredients and nutraceuticals has evoked that are specifically tailored to rectify dietary malfunctions. The multi-targeted nutraceuticals are also employed as an adjuvant therapy to pharmaceuticals due to their safe status and usage in folk medicine. Outcomes of various research investigations have proven the efficacy of nutraceuticals like catechins. thymoguinone, allicin and lignans etc. against several physiological ailments. The concept that dietary alterations can modify gene expression suggests that what we eat has even more profound implications than had previously been believed. Globally, the market statistics regarding functional foods is tremendously increasing and outpacing the traditional processed foods. Thus, a scientific activity is the need of time to promote the practical applications of therapeutic, clinical and public health nutrition. Moreover, a platform is required to explore new avenues for future collaboration and professional engagements in a meaningful and productive manner. Considering the aforementioned perspectives, a two days international conference is being arranged by the Functional and Nutraceutical Food Research Section, National Institute of Food Science and Technology, University of Agriculture, Faisalabad under the PAK-US Science and Technology Cooperation Program.

FAISALABAD

Faisalabad, previously called as Lyallpur, named after Sir James B. Lyall, Governor of the Punjab 1887-1892. After independence in 1947, the city is continuously stepping ahead to success. The city was named as "Faisalabad" in 1977 in the commemoration of King Faisal-bin-Abdul Aziz of Saudi Arabia. It is the 3rd largest metropolis in Pakistan with an estimated population of 5.4 million, situated 145 Km to the west of Lahore (Puniab). Faisalabad is famous for its textile industry and is termed as "Manchester of Pakistan". The city center was designed by Captain Poham Young, to imitate the UK Union Jack Flag with eight roads radiating



from a large clock tower. Faisalabad district has earned a name for agricultural productivity due to its rich soil aided by an efficient irrigation system.

UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE, FAISALABAD

The University of Agriculture, Faisalabad (UAF) emerged as a result of up-gradation of the famous Punjab Agricultural College and Research Institute (PACRI) in 1961. Since its inception, the scope of studies has broadened up to manifold to include the diverse curricula. The university campus is spread over an area of 1950 acres, representing both history and the present epoch. The new campus is lush green with a conglomeration of monolithic blocks built in modern style

whilst, the old building is a reminiscent of the traditional architecture. The UAF has been positioned 98th best university worldwide and 20th in Asia for Agricultural Sciences as per ranking established by National Taiwan University. Moreover, U.I. Green Metric World University ranking declared UAF the 35th best university in the entire world. Likewise, PCST ranked this university as the top university of Pakistan in degree awarding institutions.

NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF FOOD SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

The National Institute of Food Science & Technology (NIFSAT) was initially established as Food Technology Section in the Punjab Agricultural College and Research Institute. It was given the status of Department in 1962. Realizing the importance of food sector in Pakistan, the



Department was upgraded to Institute of Food Science and Technology in 2003 which was further elevated to the National Institute of Food Science & Technology in 2007. Presently, NIFSAT is the pioneer institute offering degree programs leading to Food Science and Technology, Human Nutrition and Dietetics, Food Safety and Quality Management, Food Service Management and Dairy Science and Technology. Besides, NIFSAT has strong interactions with public and private sector institutions/organizations at national and international levels. Ever since its establishment, the Institute has produced trained manpower for the food sector. The Institute has recently established Functional and Nutraceutical Food Research Section

under the Pak-US joint project being run by Prof Dr. M.S. Butt (PAK side) and Dr. Hang Xiao (US side). Accordingly, state of the art research is being carried out for the exploration of indigenous health enhancing food ingredients. Besides, NIFSAT has recently established a Nutraculture laboratory to investigate the restorative potential of nutraceuticals against cancer insurgence.

THEMES OF THE CONFERENCE

The core program of two days conference will be divided into oral presentations and poster session regarding conference themes. The topics covered shall be:

- ♦ Novel approaches in nutritional therapies
- ♦ Functional foods and nutraceuticals

- ◆ Trends in food fortification and supplementation


