



INTERNATIONAL ENTOMOLOGICAL CONGRESS (ONE EXCLUSIVE DAY ON CURRENT SCENARIO AND MANAGEMENT OF PINK BOLLWORM) ON DECEMBER 16-18, 2016 ORGANIZED BY DEPARTMENT OF ENTOMOLOGY, UAF

Pakistan Entomological Society (PES) was founded in 1974 with a view to promote the science of Entomology by providing the research scientists a forum to present their finding and discuss ways and means to overcome difficulties faced in the on-going research. Under the umbrella of PES, Young Entomological Society (YES) and Pakistan Entomologist are actively serving the research community and other stakeholders. YES has been organizing seminars and workshops on various National and International Entomological Pest Issues. The subject of Entomology has expanded to new dimensions in the last decade due to overwhelming production of major crops with transgenic sources and appearance of secondary pest to the level of primary and regular status replacing most of the earlier notorious pests. Insecticides usage has increased many folds in tandem with above pest position. Recent changes in climate and global warming are also blamed for aggravating pest problem in certain ecosystems. A blatant example is emergence and spread of dengue mosquitoes in short span of time in Pakistan and is persistent in Punjab since 2010. Citrus greening due to psyllid transmitting bacterium has also become a threat to devastate kinnow production in Punjab province. Cotton ecosystem under Bt varieties is another example where mealybug, whitefly and dusky cotton bug have played havoc and took heavy toll in terms of yield in certain years. Recently, Pink Bollworm (PBW) has emerged as menace, difficult to manage in cotton growing areas and this congress intends to encompass the various technical issues related to the biology and control strategies. A day in the congress has been fixed to arrange discussions on the above as well. The purpose of this congress is to provide an International forum for the presentations and discussions on various aspects of entomological research. The participants will be encouraged to present research findings or theoretical models that may range in focus from crop production technology to large scale ecosystem processes. Enhancing productivity of food and fiber crops on sustainable basis through cutting edge and innovative area-wide management of congress is designed to focus on oral presentations related to insect pests of the agronomic, horticultural, forest as well as greenhouse crops. Specific areas for presentations have been earmarked in insect ecosystems, bioinformatics, molecular biology, bio-diversity, conservation, trophic relations, invasiveness, econometrics of insect management program and entomological cottage industries.
