PENALTY IMPOSED

1. The Disciplinary Advisory Committee of the University in its recommendations made after following the prescribed procedure laid down under the UAF Students (Discipline and Conduct) Regulations, 1978, found (i) Mr. Jamshed Haider, Regd. No. 2015-ag-7071, B.Sc. (Hons.) Agri. Sciences, 3rd Semester, involved in (i) unethical activities (ii) damaging reputation and bringing bad name to the University. (ii) Mr. Muhammad Mahran Aslam, Regd. No. 2011-ag-2998, M.Sc. (Hons.) P.B.G. 3rd Semester, involved in (i) black mailing, threatening, harassing a female student for dire consequences (ii) damaging the moral character and defaming the personnel reputation of a female student and (iii) damaging the reputation and bringing bad name to the University. Accordingly, in view of recommendations of the Committee duly approved by the Competent Authority, the Dean concerned in exercise of the powers conferred upon them under the said Regulations, have imposed the penalties upon the involved students as mentioned. Their entry into main, PARS and sub campuses is strictly banned. They are directed to vacate the hostel accommodation, immediately, if any.

In exercise of the powers under Regulation 17a (1), (4) & (5) and 4 (ii) of the UAF Students (Discipline & Conduct) Regulations, 1978 and on the recommendations of Campus Advisory Committee, DSA hereby impose the following penalties upon Case No. (i) Mr. Ahmad Mahmood, Regd. No. 2015-ag-2371, M.Sc. Computer Science, 3rd Semester, on having been found, Indiscipline and misconduct by pushing a male student forcibly into a class room during lecture, Case No. (ii) Miss Saba Mahmood, Regd. No. 2015-ag-1510, M.Sc. Botany, on having been found Indiscipline and misconduct by inviting an outsider in the University, fined Rs. 2000/- only, warned to be careful in future and withdrawal of financial concessions for one semester respectively. Case No. (iii) Mr. Muhammad Faran Tahir, Regd. No. 2016-ag-6463, B.Sc. (Hons.) Agri. Sciences, 1st Semester on having been found guilty of cheating and deceiving the administration, fined Rs. 1000/- only, warned to be careful in future and withdrawal of financial concession for one semester.
