EXPELLED FROM THE UNIVERSITY

The Disciplinary Committee of the University in its recommendations made after following the prescribed procedure laid down under the UAF, Students (Discipline & Conduct) regulations, 1978, found the under-mentioned students involved in (i) act of immoral activities in PARS hostel (ii) threatening fellow students and promulgating indecency (iii) damaging repute and bringing bad name to the University. Accordingly, in view of said recommendations of the Disciplinary Advisory Committee duly approved by the Competent Authority, the Principal concerned in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under the relevant regulations, has imposed the penalties upon the involved students as mentioned against their names. Their entry into main, PARS and sub Campuses during the penalty period is strictly banned. They are directed to vacate hostel accommodation, immediately, if any, (i) Mr. Muhammad Samran, Regd. No. 2015-ag-5354, Intermediate (Pre-Agriculture), 4th Semester. (ii) Mr. Awais Ahmad Mand, Regd. No. 2015-ag-5174, Intermediate (Pre-Agriculture), 4th Semester (iii) Mr. Muhammad Yasir Mahmood, Regd. No. 2015-ag-5240, Intermediate (Pre-Agriculture), 4th Semester, expelled from the University Forever from spring, 2016-2017 respectively (iv) Mr. Kaleem Ullah, Regd. No. 2015-ag-5133, Intermediate (Pre-Agriculture), 4th Semester, expelled from the University for two academic years (Four Semesters) from Spring, 2016-2017. As permissible under Regulation 19(1) of the relevant Regulations, the above students, if so desire, may file individual appeal(s) to the Vice Chancellor within thirty(30) days from the date of issuance of this notification. They may also file review appeal(s) against the orders passed on their appeal(s), if contrary to pray made in the appeal within fifteen (15) days from the announcement of the orders on the appeal(s), as provided under Regulation 20(1) of the relevant Regulations.

No. 2015-ag-3657, M.Sc. Education, 4th semester, respectively on having been found them guilty of indiscipline and misconduct. The fine must be deposited in Account No. 11-09, National Bank of Pakistan, UAF Branch within ten (10) days of the issuance of this Notification. The Bank Challan showing payment of fine must be submitted in the office of the DSA within the stipulated period failing which the name of the defaulter will be struck off from the University rolls by the Dean/Director concerned. The defaulter shall not be entitled to file an appeal unless depositing the amount of fine. ELIGIBILITY

- Pakistani citizens with strong academic histories, residing and working in Pakistan and committed to returning and serving Pakistan are welcome to apply.
- All disciplines are eligible except clinical medicine. Applicants are especially encouraged in Energy, Water, Agriculture, Health, and Education.
- Eligible Master's applicants will have a four-year Bachelor's degree or a Bachelor's and Master's combination (16 years of formal education) and PhD applicants will have Master's, M.Phil. or a comparable degree (18 years of formal education) from an accredited university.
- The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) is required for all applicants. The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) will be required for short-listed applicants.

This is a national program. However, women, people with disabilities, and students from FATA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, AJK, Gilgit/Baltistan, Balochistan, Northern Sindh and Southern Punjab are especially encouraged to apply.
