NOTIFICATION

On observance that University Employees/retired Employees are purchasing medicines for eradication of HCV from certain chemists & druggists at different rates and in order to revisit the existing policy with regard to reimbursement of medical treatment of HCV, a meeting of the committee consisting of the Registrar, Treasurer, Resident Auditor and the Senior Medical Officer was held on 03-04-2017. On the recommendations of the Committee, the Vice Chancellor has been pleased to approve the following policy to entertain medical reimbursement cases of HCV treatment with uniform rates as follows:-

1.	A sum of Rs. 3200/- pm, the lowest rate for which the HCV medicine is available at Shahzad Medicines Company may be reimbursed to University employees/retired employees, for a period of six months.
2.	In case of the treatment of HCV is taken through injection/vials an amount of Rs. 4400/- per month for a period of six months may be reimbursed to the concerned employees.
3.	The implementation on decision of 15% deduction from total payment while making reimbursement of amount may henceforth the stopped.
4.	The rate of reimbursement for HCV treatment will quarterly be reviewed by S.M.O.

On the recommendations of the Committee, the Vice Chancellor has further been pleased to approve following policy for reimbursement of stents being used for Cardiac treatment of University Employees, retired employees and their family members: - Minimum amount of Rs. 20,811/- and maximum of Rs. 1,33,750/- will be reimbursed to the university Employees on the purchase of stents on the advice of the Senior Medical Officer in future. The Vice Chancellor has also approved to direct university employees that their medical reimbursement claims should be routed through their respective Deans/Directors Principals/Chairmen of Teaching Departments. The medical reimbursement claims of retired University employees should be routed through office of the

Registrar or the office Incharge of concerned Department from where the University Employee retired from service. The medical cases which can satisfactorily be treated at University Hospital will not be referred to the Medical Specialists. The prescriptions of the Medical Officer/Women Medical Officer/Senior Medical Officer where needed will be entertained for reimbursement.

No. 13, Tunnel Farming, Diploma, they are expelled from the University forever from the year 2017 respectively.
