



WEARING OF UNIVERSITY IDENTITY CARDS AT THE CAMPUS

The Vice Chancellor while chairing Dean's Committee meeting, expressed his concerns that during his visit to various faculties, it has been observed that teachers, staff and students were not wearing their University identity Cards in the classrooms. The Vice Chancellor directed to implement decision taken by the Dean's Committee with regard to wearing of University Identity Cards with the specified colour of stripe as follows:- (i) Blue for Faculty Members (ii) Yellow for Students (iii) Green for Staff (iv) Pink for retired Officers/Officials. The Vice Chancellor further desired that all the Deans should convene meetings of the Board of Faculties and discuss the modus operandi so that students and faculty should implement the above decision. It was emphasized that no student should be allowed to enter in the classroom without University identity card. Similarly the faculty members should also wear the identity cards. In case of non compliance imposition of fine will be the last option for which Registrar Office should put up a proposal for implementation.

RIGHT TO INFORMATION POLICY UAF

Article 19-A of the Constitution of Pakistan guarantees the "Right to Information" as a fundamental right. The Punjab Transparency and Right Information Act, 2013 (RTI Act) was enacted to allow citizens to exercise this right. In order to achieve the goals of transparency and good governance, the UAF has established the following policy to process requests for information received by UAF. (A) Please direct all requests for information to Prof. Dr. M. Jalal Arif, Public Information Officer. All communication with the applicants will be conducted by the UAF Public Information Officer. Internal review requests may be submitted to jalalarif807@yahoo.com. (B) **Request Guidelines:** The request for information should be as clear and specific as possible. Please refrain from asking open-ended questions. Please avoid subjective questions based on speculation. It is easier for UAF to process requests for information based on objective facts and concerns. (C) **Procedure:** UAF will acknowledge receipt of the request for information. UAF will process the request as soon as possible as per Section 10 of the RTI Act, and as long as producing the information does not interfere with its operations. If the information falls under any of the exemptions under Section 13 of the RTI Act, the applicant of the request will be informed of the reason for refusal to disclose the information. If the application is refused, the applicant may re-submit the request by modifying it in accordance with this policy and the RTI Act. If possible, UAF may direct the applicant to the relevant person who may provide access to the exempted information. The applicant may submit a request for internal review of the application decision to the UAF Administration as per Section 12 of the RTI Act. Upon receipt of a request for internal review, the UAF Administration has the discretion to confirm, modify or reverse the decision of the UAF Public Information Officer. (D) Upon receipt of a request, the UAF Public Information Officer will determine if the information falls under any of the exemptions under Section 13 of the RTI Act. The exemptions include anything that is likely to harm: national defence or security, public order or international relations of Pakistan. A legitimate privacy interest, unless the person concerned has consented to disclosure of the information. The protection of legally privileged information or of the rules relating to breach of confidence. The legitimate commercial interests of a public body or a third party, including information subject to third party intellectual property rights. The life, health or safety of any person. The prevention or detection of crime, the apprehension or

prosecution of offenders, or the administration of justice. The ability of the Government to manage the economy. The effective formulation of or success of a policy either by its premature disclosure or by restraining the free and frank provision of advice within the Government. RIGHT TO INFORMATION REQUESTS: UAF PROCEDURE. Designate a UAF official who will be the "Public Information Officer" (PIO). The PIO will have an email address and physical drop-box/office to receive requests. The PIO will acknowledge the receipt of a request. UAF administration will decide whether to release the information or deny it based on an exemption or because the request is not clearly written. Requests should be processed within 14 days of receipt according to the law. This time can be extended by another 14 days if needed. If the request asks for copies or electronic access, UAF can charge the applicant according to the Punjab Transparency and Right to Information Act payments schedule. UAF is not obligated to provide access in the form requested especially if it interferes with UAF operations. (e.g. records that don't exist in electronic forms don't have to be provided in electronic forms as it would be inconvenient to scan and upload them). If the UAF administration decides that the request cannot be granted, the PIO will communicate that with a brief reason to the applicant. If the applicant wants to submit the decision for "Internal review" this means it will go back to the UAF administration directly to reconsider (provide email address). UAF administration has the discretion to confirm, modify or reverse the original decision.

RE-CONDUCT OF GRE (SUBJECT) TYPE TEST FOR PhD ADMISSION

The competent authority of the University allowed to re-conduct GRE (subject) type test for PhD admission for Winter Semester, 2017-18 on 03-10-2017 instead of 30-09-2017. Applications for GRE (Subject) type test will be received upto 29-09-2017.

NOTIFICATION

1. As provided under the relevant regulation a student may be permitted to revise his/her GS/10 form within 20 days from the commencement of classes. After this period he/she may be allowed to revise GS/10 form upto 28th days from the commencement of classes on payment of prescribed GS/10 revision fee (Rs. 1000/-). Furthermore, the postgraduate students may revise GS/10 form for Winter Semester, 2017-18 in accordance with the following regulation. "For minor and major changes in the GS/10 form the student will pay a fine of Rs. 3000/- and 5000/- respectively. However, it will be notified by the office of the Director Graduate Studies".
2. The competent authority of the University has allowed the postgraduate students to deposit dues/complete enrolment formalities for Winter Semester, 2017-18 with fine of Rs. 2000/- alongwith double late fee Rs. 1200/-(2000+1200=3200) up to 25-09-2017 who could not deposit dues within due date and failed to complete enrolment formalities. However, such students would be themselves responsible for the consequences (if any) of late enrolment.

PENALTY IMPOSED
