CUSTODY OF SERVICE BOOKS

It is informed that with a view to implement the decision of the Syndicate taken at its meeting held on 28-06-2014 in its true spirit, it is requested that:- (i) All the officials who are drawing salaries from the University are advised to prepare their duplicate service books. WEARING OF UNIVERSITY IDENTITY CARDS AT THE CAMPUS

The Vice Chancellor while chairing Dean's Committee meeting, expressed his concerns that during his visit to various faculties, it has been observed that teachers, staff and students were not wearing their University Identity Cards in the classrooms. The Vice Chancellor directed to implement decision taken by the Dean's Committee with regard to wearing of University Identity Cards with the specified colour of stripe as follows:- (i) Blue for Faculty Members (ii) Yellow for Students (iii) Green for Staff (iv) Pink for retired Officers/Officials. The Vice Chancellor further desired that all the Deans should convene meetings of the Board of Faculties and discuss the modus operandi so that students and faculty should implement the above decision. It was emphasized that no student should be allowed to enter in the classroom without University Identity card. Similarly the faculty members should also wear the Identity cards. In case of non compliance, imposition of fine will be the last option for which Registrar Office should put up a proposal for implementation.



PhD THESIS/SYNOPSIS DEFENSE

1. Mr. Ijaz Ahmad, Regd. No. 2010-ag-3210, a PhD student, Department of Agronomy, has successfully defended his PhD synopsis on 21-10-2017. The title of his synopsis is "Management of weed seed bank dynamics through different agronomic practices and its implications on growth and yield of maize".
2. Mr. Lillah, Regd. No. 2012-ag-781, Student of PhD Food Technology at National Institute of Food Science & Technology, UAF, has successfully defended his PhD synopsis on 20-10-2017. The committee has suggested some minor changes in the title. Now the title of his PhD synopsis is "Characterization of selected wheat varieties grown in Punjab in relation to end product quality".

The title of his thesis is "Improvement of heat tolerance potential in chilli genotypes through exogenous application of glycine betaine". NOTIFICATION

The competent authority of the University has allowed the postgraduate students (old) to deposit dues/complete enrolment formalities for Winter Semester, 2017-18 with fine Rs. 6000/- alongwith normal dues up to 31-10-2017 who could not deposit dues within due date and failed to complete enrolment formalities. However, such students would be themselves responsible for the consequences (if any) of late enrolment.

PENALTY IMPOSED

The Disciplinary Advisory Committee of the University in its recommendations made after following the prescribed procedure laid down under the UAF, Students (Discipline and Conduct) Regulations, 1978, found the under mentioned student involved in (i) Teasing, chasing and disturbing to a University female student and (ii) Damaging repute and bringing bad name to the University. Accordingly, in view of said recommendations of the Disciplinary Advisory Committee duly approved by the Competent Authority, the Dean concerned in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under the relevant Regulations, has imposed the penalty upon the involved student as mentioned against his name. His entry into main, PARS and sub campuses during the penalty period is strictly banned, He is directed to vacate hostel accommodation, immediately, if any:- Mr. Usman Shafique, Regd. No. 2015-ag-6687, B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, 5th Semester (Major Forestry), expelled from the University forever from Winter, 2017-2018. As permissible under Regulation 19(1) of the relevant Regulations, the above student, if so desire, may file individual appeal to the Vice Chancellor within thirty days from the date of issuance of this notification. He may also file review appeal(s) against the orders passed on his appeal, if contrary to pray made in the appeal within fifteen(15) days from the announcement of the orders on the appeal as provided under Regulation 20(1) of the relevant Regulations.
