



FORMAL LAUNCHING OF CENTERS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES US-PAKISTAN

US Under Secretary of State for Public Affairs and Public Diplomacy Richard Stengel and US Ambassador to Pakistan Richard G. Olson, along with Minister for Water and Power Khawaja Muhammad Asif, officially launched the U.S.-Pakistan Centers for Advanced Studies (USPCAS), a \$127 million investment from the United States building partnerships in higher education and research. USPCAS, will focus on finding viable long-term solutions to Pakistan's greatest priorities. The \$127 million, five-year initiative will provide opportunities for joint research, facilitate faculty and student exchanges, and link academia and the private sector through policy development in the areas of agriculture and food security, energy and water. Speaking at the Inaugural Ceremony, Prof. Dr. Iqar Ahmed appreciated the efforts of US and Pakistan team from diplomats, administration and academia and ensured that the project would lead to the achievement of empirical solutions of the issues faced in the field of Agriculture and Food Security, Water and Energy. Prof. Dr. Iqar mentioned that "USPCAS in Agriculture and Food Security anticipations that by this consortia Pakistani Agro driven economy will move to Entrepreneurial Agro Economy". The US-Pakistan Centers for Advanced Studies will be housed in four leading Pakistani and US universities. The University of Agriculture, Faisalabad, (UAF) and the University of California at Davis will partner to create the center for agriculture and food security, both the National University of Sciences and Technology (NUST) and the University of Engineering and Technology, Peshawar, will partner with Arizona State University to create two centers for energy research; the University of Jamshoro and the University of Utah will partner to create the center for water.

A panel discussion on the role of three newly established Centers for Advanced Studies in Agriculture and Food Security, Energy and Water held at HEC Secretariat on Thursday, June 04, 2015 at HEC, Islamabad. These centers have been established respectively at National University of Sciences and Technology, UET Peshawar, University of Agriculture, Faisalabad (UAF) and Mehran University, Jamshoro. USAID, Vice Chancellors, Members of National and Provincial Assemblies, academicians, researchers, senior Government officials and other stakeholders attended the discussion. Speaking at the opening ceremony, Dr. Mukhtar Ahmed, Chairman, Higher Education Commission said that, "he expect that the centers will be innovative and provide cutting-edge research, enhance teaching and learning, entrepreneurship activities, and strengthen policy formulation for the Government of Pakistan". The legacy of these centers dates back to 50 years of cooperation, progress, and shared vision for advancement of education, science, technology, agriculture, and commerce. These centers will work on research and policy and actively engage in policy dialogue and setting research agendas that improve the lives of Pakistanis and promotes economic



growth, besides creation of a cadre of effective managers for private and public sector in the agriculture, water and energy sectors. The discussion on Agriculture and Food Security was moderated by Prof. Dr. Iqrar Ahmad. The panel members involved in the discussion were prominent subject experts like Dr. Muhammad Jameel Khan, Agriculture Policy Expert, USPCAS-AFS, UAF, Dr. Muhammad Jahanzeb Masood Cheema, Precision Agriculture Expert, USPCAS-AFS, UAF, Dr. Ashfaq Ahmed Chattha, Climate Change Expert, USPCAS-AFS, UAF, Dr. Thomas L. Rost, Professor Emeritus, CBS Plant Biology, Special Assistant, CAES International Program, USPCAS-AFS, UCD, Dr. Muhammad Anjum Ali, Director General Agriculture Extension and Agriculture Research, Mr. Sayed Faisal Hassan, Farmer, Mr. Hassan Ali Chanio, Farmer from Sindh and Dr. Kausar Abdullah Malik, Prof. for Biotechnology, Post Graduate Studies. Speaking at the discussion, Prof. Dr. Iqrar Ahmed asserted that academicians and Agriculture scientists should find ways and bring solutions of the indigenous problems pertaining to Pakistan's Food Security and Climate Change.
