On the recommendations of the external examiners and after fulfilling all the requirements, Fatma Hussain D/o Munawar Hussain, Reg. No. 92-ag-1484, Department of Chemistry and Bio-chemistry, and Semeem Mumtaz D/o Muhammad Mumtaz, Reg. No. 96-ag-1729, National Institute of Food Science & Technology, have passed the final examinations for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy-2009. The Vice Chancellor is pleased to sanction their admissions to the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy-2009. The titles of their thesis are "Skin glycation in diabetic complications" and "Production of xylooligosaccharides from agricultural wastes for preparation of symbiotic food" respectively.
