JOHN ALLWRIGHT FELLOWSHIPS FOR 2010

Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research is calling applications for John Allwright Fellowships for study at Australian Universities commencing in 2010. The primary aim of the fellowship scheme is to enhance research capacity in ACIAR's partner country institutions. Through the fellowship award, funding is provided for research staff engaged on ACIAR projects to obtain postgraduate qualifications in Australian Universities. Although applications are welcome from participants in both bilateral and multilateral (IARC) projects, applicants must be working in the following ACIAR partner priority countries to be eligible. Currently these are: (i) Papua-New Guinea, and in the Pacific-Fiji, Samoa, Tonga, Solomon Islands, Vanuatu, Kirabati (ii) In SE Asia – East Timor, Indonesia, Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Philippines (iii) In South Asia – India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, (iv) In North Asia – Western China, and (v) the Republic of South Africa.
